NYSPFP Fall and Injury Prevention Initiative

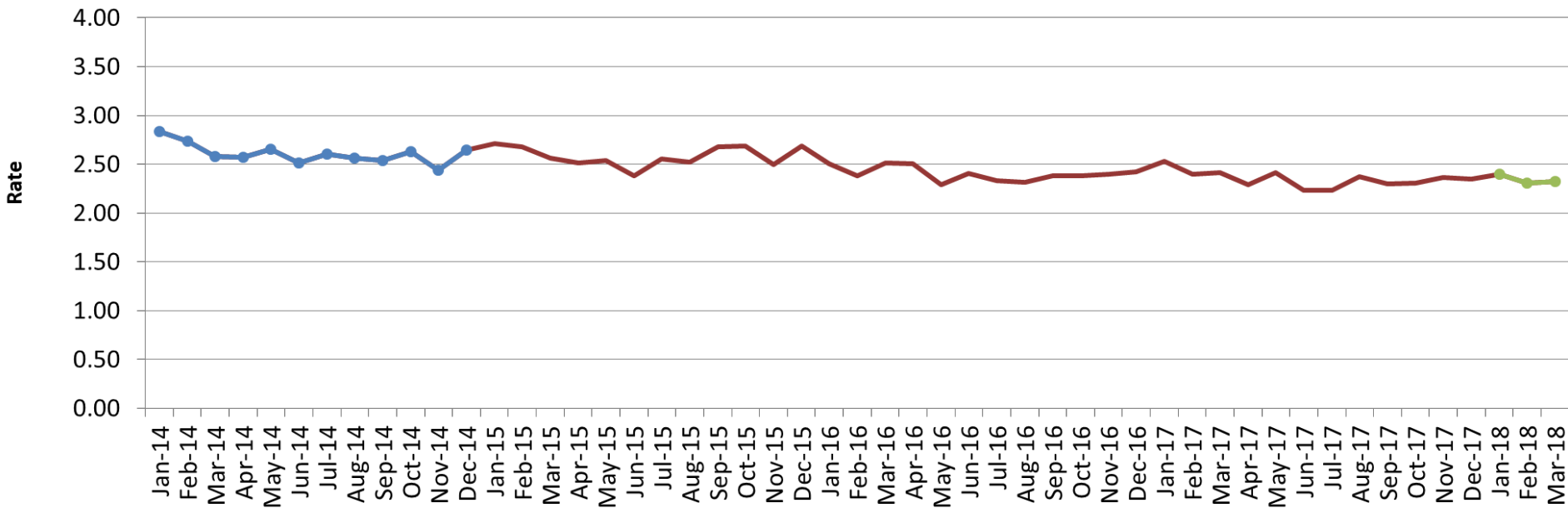
- Goal: To reduce Falls and Injury by 20%

Falls Rate Baseline Comparison



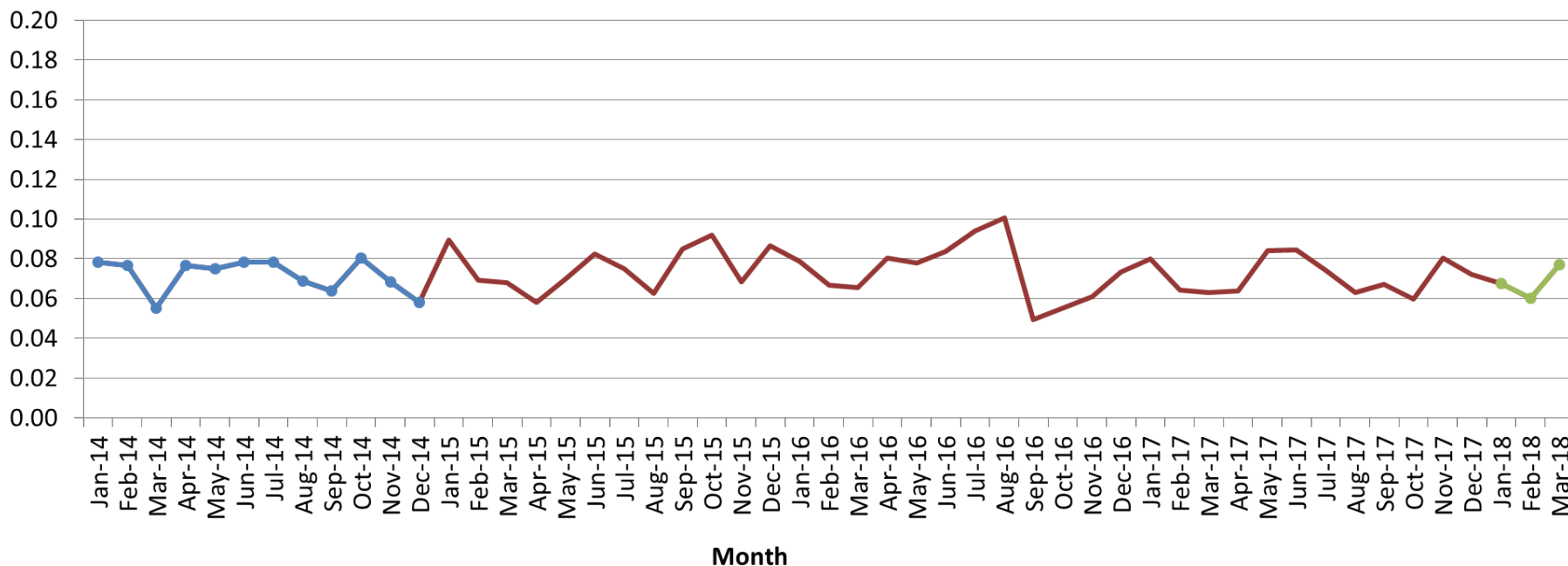

Falls Rate Baseline Comparison



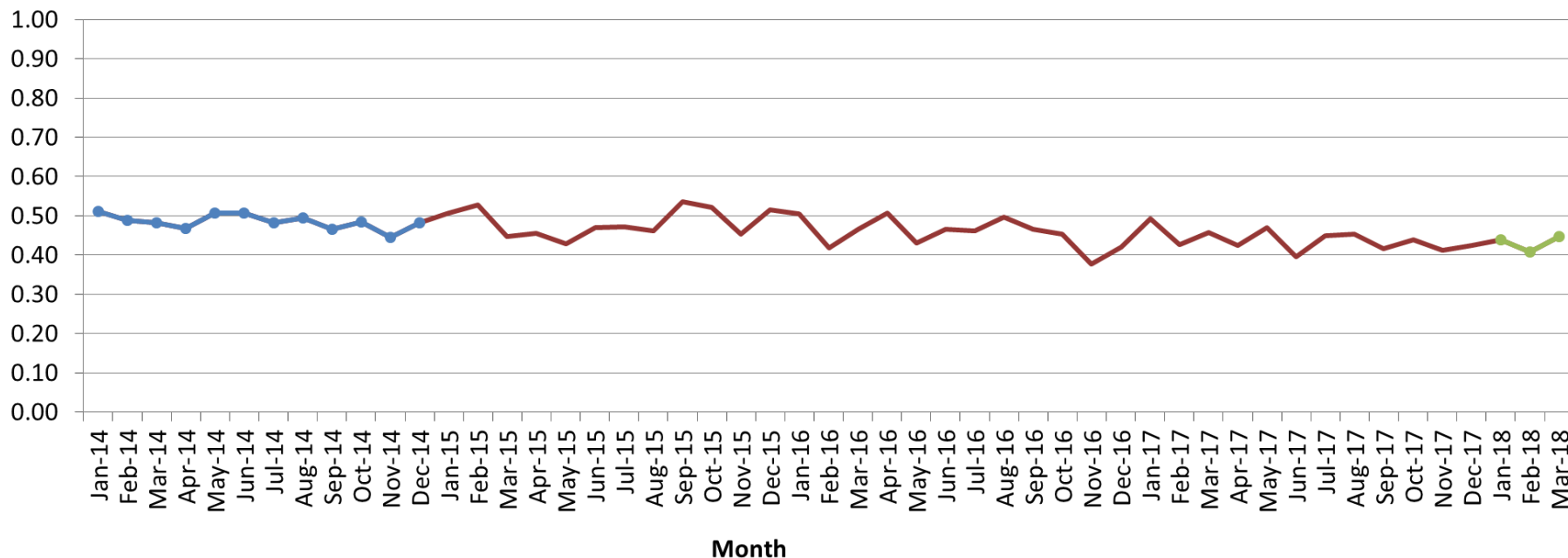
